The donation process is quick and painless, and most blood donation centers are conveniently located.

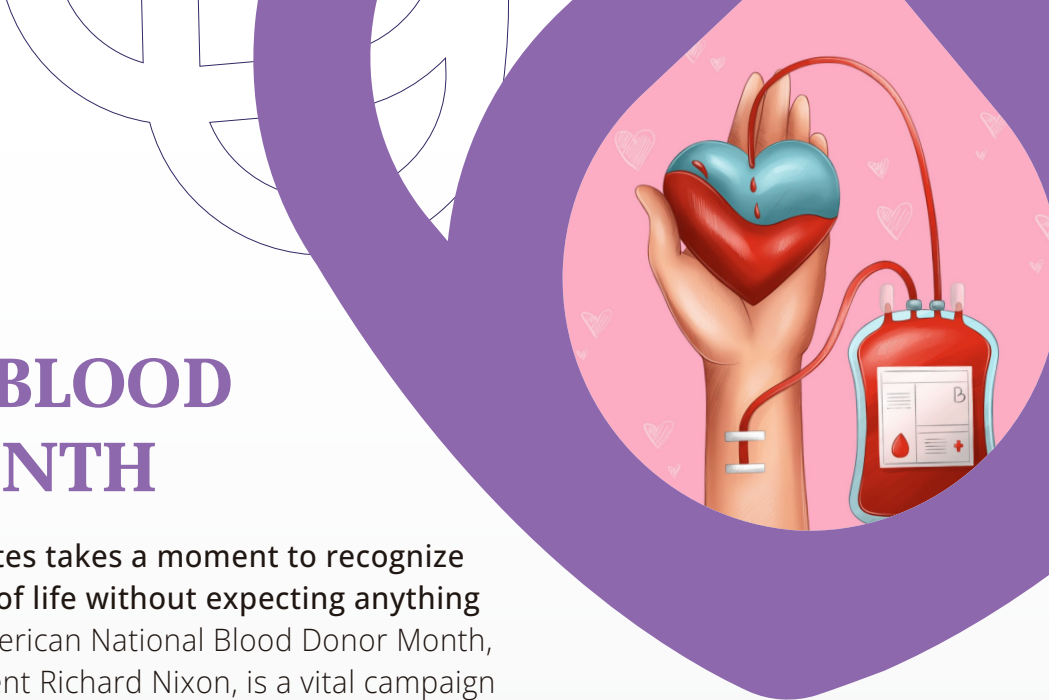
